RE: ASSA TEST SUBMISSION FEES 2026

To whom it may concern

Test submission fees for 2026

- Submission: R9 000 for ATP (Association of Test Publishers) South Africa Members.
R12 000 (Non ATP South Africa Members).

ATP South Africa Members can apply for a R3 250 rebate on their first assessment submitted for certification by ASSA during 2025.

After the first submission/review, should your test be found to be non-compliant in terms of the ASSA test review criteria, you will be informed about this by the Senior Editor with recommendations in this regard.

If you wish to act on the recommendations to achieve ASSA test compliance, you can re-submit your test/send additional material or information within 6(six) months after the outcome of the first submission was communicated to you, with an administration fee of R500.

Should your test require a complete, new review process after the submission of the additional material, you'll be notified, and this will incur a cost of R4 500. ASSA therefore urge test submitters to familiarise themselves with the requirements for a sound and comprehensive test manual. This will ensure that you avoid re-submission or adding on additional material.

A time lapse of more than 6(six) months will result in the full submission fee of R9 000 (ATP South Africa Members) or R12 000 (Non ATP South Africa Members). We therefore urge you to take all necessary steps to ensure that your test meets the necessary criteria before submitting a test to ASSA.

All tests that were submitted during our trial period and were found to be non-compliant, are now out of the grace period. Should you wish to add any additional material and resubmit, this can be done at a cost of a full submission which is R9 000 (ATP South Africa Members) or R12 00 (Non ATP South Africa Members)
